



The Sukkot Window

On Sukkot we celebrate the thanksgiving festival.

Dwelling in the Sukkah reminds us of the exodus from Egypt and of those who had no possessions in the wilderness and no houses in which to live. The tables in each sukkah are formed from the letter "chai" and God's harvest bounty is heaped upon them. The sun and the moon are both represented as it is the equinox. The sky is

blessed with rain, and water is drawn from the earth. The four symbolic species – willow, myrtle, palm and the etrog – are shaken in celebration of God's abundance.
