This membership category will cover any individual or family/partnership for both the generation who is paying the fee plus any family members below the age of 50 years and above the age of 85 years.

- TBI offers King David School families a 50% discount on their membership fees, and KDS reduces tuition fees equivalent to 50% of TBI membership fees.
